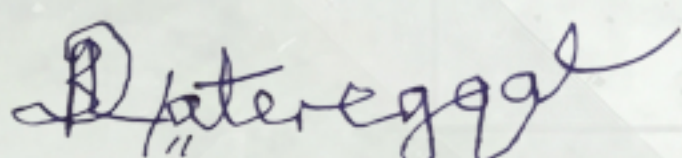
His Majesty leaves behind an extraordinary legacy of leadership, service, compassion and commitment to the advancement of his people and the development of Uganda.
